

Jim Henson Charts!

I made and used these charts to create a blanket for Tournament 3 of Nerd Wars on Ravelry. I gifted this blanket to my sister for Christmas. This PDF download is for the purpose of sharing my charts in a more printer-friendly manner. Please use these charts for your own personal use and not for the use of selling the items. These characters are not my creation and are owned by Jim Henson Studios/Walt Disney.

For my blanket I used Red Heart Super Saver worsted weight yarn. Each section of color took about 1 skein. For example, all the gold color used in the blanket came from one skein of gold. I used size 8 needles and had a gauge about 4 sts and 5 rows= 1" in stockinette stitch. My advice is to obtain a gauge that is close to a square, like 4 sts & 5 rows. These charts are made in squares and my finished squares did end up a little on the rectangle size.

I would cast on the first dominate color, and then in my first row I would begin adding in the contrasting color when I would come to the appropriate stitch. I would also try to loop, or carry my yarn behind my work and not let it get carried over more than 4-6 stitches. All of my squares were binded off on a purl row. Only because of my weird amount of rows.

I crocheted all of my squares together. Also they charts work best when using contrasting colors where one color is a bit light and the other dark. I think my Kermit could have turned out better if I had used more of a contrast like I did for Miss Piggy.
