Ice Cream Pint Cozies

Pattern and charts by Robin Smallwood of Creative Unicorn Crafts



Pattern Notes:

For an even knit I suggest carrying yarn in the same way each time. I did main color on top and contrasting color underneath. Pictures later in the pattern of examples. Gauge is somewhat important so your cozy fits an actual ice cream pint!

Materials:

US 6/4.0 mm, DPN or appropriate length cable needle

Yarn: You can use any worsted weight in desired colors, Choosing a Main Color (MC) and Contrasting Color (CC) crochet hook for weaving in ends, stitch marker

Gauge:

17.5 sts + 27 rows = 4 inches/10 centimeters in stockinette stitch, finished pint cozy will measure about 5"x5" when laying flat.

Skills needed:

Knitting in the round, increasing, using two colors at once, following a chart

Abbreviations:

CO: Cast On; K: Knit; K1: Knit one; K1fb: Knit one stitch in the front and back of the same stitch, creating an increase; P1: Purl one, BO: Bind off

Cozy

DPN instructions:

With main color, CO 22, divide evenly on 3 needles (7,7,8), join in round, place marker to indicate first stitch or needle, however you want to keep track of your rows – Your cozy will have a small hole in the bottom

row 1: K

row 2: *K1, K1fb, K to last 2 stitches, K1fb, K1 * repeat this per needle (28 stitches)

row 3: K

row 4: repeat row 2 (34 stitches)

row 5: K

row 6: repeat row 2 (40 stitches)

Magic Loop instructions:

With main color, CO 22, join in the round, placing a marker to indicate first stitch, however you want to keep track of your rows – Your cozy will have a small hole in the bottom

row 1: K

row 2: K1, K1fb, K3, K1fb, K2, K1fb, K3, K1fb, K2, K1fb, K4, K1fb, K1(28 stitches)

row 3: K

row 4: K1, K1fb, K5, K1fb, K2, K1fb, K5, K1fb, K2, K1fb, K6, K1fb, K1 (34 stitches)

row 5: K


row 6: K1, K1fb, K7, K1fb, K2, K1fb, K7, K1fb, K2, K1fb, K8, K1fb, K1 (40 stitches)

row 7: Begin working the chart for the striping swirl. When you reach a row that has an increase, you'll k1fb in the first stitch to continue the striping pattern, and you'll k1fb on the last stitch.

row 22: *k1 p1* repeat from 8 to *

row 23: repeat row 22

row 24: BO



Finishing

To finish after binding off, you can weave in your ends, or maybe be a rebel and don't do it? Or maybe be a rebel and actually do it since 90% of us just tuck the ends in without weaving in haha

Carrying two colors at once with ease:

Getting ready to carry the black yarn on top, and then the white yarn underneath that.
