# Lunar New Year Snake Cozies

### **Pattern Notes:**

Gauge is somewhat important so your cozy fits an actual can! Different yarn weights - even if they all say worsted weight can vary in thickness which can vary the size of your cozy when it comes to length. Can cozy knit in the round.

# Materials:

US 6/4.0 mm, DPN or appropriate length cable needle, tapestry needle, stitch marker if needed for beginning of row, Yarn: You can use any worsted weight in desired colors, tapestry needle.

# Gauge:

17.5 sts + 27 rows = 4 inches/10 centimeters in stockinette stitch, finished can cozie will measure around 5"x4.5"

### Skills needed:

Knitting in the round, increasing, i-cord

### Abbreviations:

CO: Cast On; K: Knit; K1: Knit one; K1fb: Knit one stitch in the front and back of the same stitch, creating an increase; P1: Purl one, BO: Bind off

# Can Cozy

### **DPN** instructions:

With red, CO 12, divide evenly on 3 needles, join in round, place marker to indicate first stitch or needle, however you want to keep track of your rows – Your cozy will have a small hole in the bottom

row 1: K

row 2: \*K1, K1fb, K1fb, K1\* Repeat this per needle (18 stitches)

row 3: K

row 4: \*K1, K1fb, K to last 2 stitches, K1fb, K1 \* repeat this per needle (24 stitches)

row 5: K

row 6: repeat row 4 (30 stitches)

row 7: K

row 8: repeat row 4 (36 stitches)

## Magic Loop instructions:

With red, CO 12, join in the round, placing a marker to indicate first stitch, however you want to keep track of your rows – Your cozy will have a small hole in the bottom

row 1: K

row 2: K1, K1fb, K1fb, K1, repeat this two times more (18 stitches)

row 3: K

row 4: K1, K1fb, K2, K1fb, K1, repeat this two times more (24 stitches)

row 5: K

row 6: K1, K1fb, K4, K1fb, K1, repeat this two times more (30 stitches)

row 7: K

row 8: K1, K1fb, K6, K1fb, K1, repeat this two times more (36 stitches)

### Can cozie continued:

Body of cozy starts row 1

row 1-21: K

row 22: \*K1, P1\* from star to star row 23: \*K1, P1\* from star to star

row 24: BO

For the snake:

Knit an I-cord for about 7 inches

next row: K1, K1fb, K1 (4)

K3 more rows

next row: K2, K1fb, K1 (5)

K1 row

next row: k2 tog, K1, K2 tog (3)

K1 row

next rowL K2 tog, k1, BO last two stitches

Stitch your snake onto your cozy in a snake like pattern, I liked making mine all scrunched up! I found it easiest to stitch the snake in place while on a can. I thought another cool way to stitch the snake on would be to have it wrap around the cozy. You'd want to likely make it longer than I suggested.





Weave in the ends, or don't. No judgment from me!
