# Unicorn Cozies

Pattern and charts by Robin Smallwood of Creative Unicorn Crafts



### **Pattern Notes:**

Gauge is somewhat important so your cozy fits an actual can! Different yarn weights - even if they all say worsted weight can vary in thickness which can vary the size of your cozy when it comes to length. Can cozy knit in the round.

# Materials:

US 6/4.0 mm, DPN or appropriate length cable needle, tapestry needle, stitch marker if needed for beginning of row, Yarn: You can use any worsted weight in desired colors. I also added buttons and googly eyes for the eyes.

## Gauge:

17.5 sts + 27 rows = 4 inches/10 centimeters in stockinette stitch, finished can cozie will measure around 5"x4.5"

## Skills needed:

Knitting in the round, sewing

## Abbreviations:

CO: Cast On; MC: Main color, K: Knit; K1: Knit one; K1fb: Knit one stitch in the front and back of the same stitch.

creating an increase; P1: Purl one, BO: Bind off

# Can Cozy

# **DPN** instructions:

With MC, CO 12, divide evenly on 3 needles, join in round, place marker to indicate first stitch or needle, however you want to keep track of your rows – Your cozy will have a small hole in the bottom

row 1: K

row 2: \*K1, K1fb, K1fb, K1\* Repeat this per needle (18 stitches)

row 3: K

row 4: \*K1, K1fb, K to last 2 stitches, K1fb, K1 \* repeat this per needle (24 stitches)

row 5: K

row 6: repeat row 4 (30 stitches)

row 7: K

row 8: repeat row 4 (36 stitches)

## Magic Loop instructions:

With MC, CO 12, join in the round, placing a marker to indicate first stitch, however you want to keep track of your rows – Your cozy will have a small hole in the bottom

row 1: K

row 2: K1, K1fb, K1fb, K1, repeat this two times more (18 stitches)

row 3: K

row 4: K1, K1fb, K2, K1fb, K1, repeat this two times more (24 stitches)

row 5: K

row 6: K1, K1fb, K4, K1fb, K1, repeat this two times more (30 stitches)

row 7: K

row 8: K1, K1fb, K6, K1fb, K1, repeat this two times more (36 stitches)

### Can cozie continued:

Body of cozy starts row 1 row 1-21: K chart below

row 22: \*K1, P1\* repeat from star to star row 23: \*K1, P1\* repeat from star to star

row 24: BO

## Horn:

CO 9 in the round, K 5 rows

row 6: \*K1, K2tog\* repeat from star to star (6 sts)

row 7,8,9: K

row 10: K2tog, K2tog, K2tog (3 sts)

row 11: K

row 12: K2tog, BO remaining stitches, pull tail tight

through loop to create a point!

I sewed the horn on at an angle to make it stick upright instead of straight out. Then I sewed buttons on for eyes and stitched a cheeky little half smile. I took bits of yarn that coordinated with my MC to create a mane and tied a knot in the middle of it. This allowed me to have something easy to sew into, and gives the mane volume when flipped to one side. For the tail I tied a knot more like a tassle. Trimmed the mane and tail and glued on googly eyes with regular white school glue. Side note - I was pleasantly surprised that my buttons and googly eyes matched in size, it wasn't intentional but I'm glad it happened!

Weave in the ends, or don't. No judgment from me!
